GIRL TALK CONCERT SHUTTLE

Information

Many students have voiced a desire for a shuttle to and from the Girl Talk concert at the State Theater in Portland on Feb. 28, 2011 at 8:00 PM. 60 students have responded to a BSG survey saying that they would like a shuttle to the concert. The total cost of the shuttle will be \$382 and will hold 45 students. Students would sign up first-come-first-serve at the Info Desk prior to the concert. If we charge students \$5 for the shuttle, it will cost BSG \$157 total to subsidize the rest.

Action Required

Facilities committee requests that BSG allocate \$157 to subsidize the cost of a shuttle to the Girl Talk concert at the State Theater in Portland on Feb. 28, 2011.
