

Procedure for Responding to Concerns of Violations Of the Club Membership Activities Policy

All concerns regarding policy violation will be brought to the attention of the BSG by any member of the Student Affairs division of the college.

The Student Organizations Oversight Committee (SOOC) will address all concerns related to Club Membership Activities. Club leaders will be asked to provide a written response and will be given the opportunity to address the committee. A majority vote of the committee will recommend a response to the President, Vice Presidents and Treasurer of the BSG. The President, Vice Presidents and Treasurer of the BSG will accept or modify the SOOC's proposed response and make all relevant parties aware of its decision.

These responses could include issuing a conditional public warning, reducing it to Charter II status, or revoking the club's charter. Reduction to Charter II status can be imposed for no more than two semesters from the response being issued. The SOOC will strive to ensure that the long-term impact of any punishment is limited.

A public report will be issued after the consideration of every concern with the names of those involved omitted. The BSG will make every effort to protect the anonymity of all students involved in this process.
